but **love** covers all **offenses**. **爱能遮掩一切过犯。**
- 13 On the lips of him who has **understanding**, **wisdom** is found, **明哲人嘴里有智慧**
but **a rod** is for the back of him who **lacks sense**. **无知人背上受刑杖。**
- 14 The **wise** lay up **knowledge**, **智慧人积存知识**,
but **the mouth of a fool** brings **ruin** near. **愚妄人的口速致败坏。**

- 18 The one who conceals hatred has lying lips, **隐藏怨恨的, 有说谎的嘴;**
And **并且**
whoever utters slander is a fool. **口出谗谤的, 是愚昧的人。**
- 19 When words are many, transgression is not lacking, **多言多语难免有过,**
but **而**
whoever restrains his lips is prudent. **禁止嘴唇是有智慧。**
- 20 The tongue of the **righteous** is **choice silver**; **义人的舌乃似高银;**
(but is implied) **而**
the heart of the wicked is of little worth. **恶人的心所值无几。**
- 21 The lips of the righteous feed many, **义人的口教养多人,**
but **而**
fools die for lack of sense. **愚昧人因无知而死亡。**
